2017 ART SHOW EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

The FIPAP Biennial Art Show is by invitation only.

Our biennial art show provides an opportunity for community artists, professionals and amateurs to show their work. Importantly, commission to FIPAP collected through the sale of your art supports FIPAP and its mission to bring arts programming to The Pines community. Additionally, FIPAP's mission includes support of other Pines support organizations including, The Pines Care Center, Whyte Hall, Pines Volunteer Fire Department and the Mobility Cart Program. Participation in the FIPAP Biennial Art Show helps the whole Pines community.

Artists wishing to be considered for inclusion this year are asked to follow these guidelines:

- Submissions must be made no later than June 30, 2017.
- Artists are required to have a bona-fide connection to Fire Island Pines.
- Artists must submit a resume including gallery exhibition history.
- Artists must submit examples of their current work with prices. This can be done by hard copy print or electronically.

Richard Des Jardins, Barbara Sahlman and Glen Wielgus curate the show and evaluate new artists' submissions.

Artists will be notified no later than July 7th, 2017, regarding participation.

45% of any art sales will be collected as commission to FIPAP. Net proceeds will be distributed to the artists approximately 30 days following the show.
