2017 ART SHOW EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

**The FIPAP Biennial Art is by invitation only.**

Our biennial art show provides an opportunity for community artists, professional and amateur to show their work. Also, and very importantly, commission to FIPAP collected through the sale of your art supports FIPAP and it's mission to bring arts programming to The Pines community. Additionally FIPAP's mission includes support of other Pines support organizations including, The Pines Care Center, Whyte Hall, Pines Volunteer Fire Department and the Mobility Cart program. Participation in the FIPAP Biennial Art Show helps the whole Pines community.

Artists wishing to be considered for inclusion this year are asked to follow these guidelines:

- **Hard copy examples of the work you wish to show, with prices, must be submitted by mail no later than July 1, 2017. Submissions must be made no later than June 30, 2017. Even if you have exhibited in the past current work samples must be submitted.**
- Artists are required to have a bona-fide connection to Fire Island Pines.
- Artists must submit a resume including gallery exhibition history.

Richard Des Jardins, Barbara Sahlman and Glen Wielgus, curate the show, evaluating new artist's submissions.

Artists will be notified no later than July 7th, 2017 regarding participation.

**45% of any art sales** will be collected as commission to FIPAP. Net proceeds will be distributed to the artists approximately 30 days following the show.
